Two more runs in the 4th cut RH's margin to 8-4. Smith and Turner again ignited the rally with a base rap and a walk, respectively. Both scored later in the imning on passed balls.

Paula Cook's base hit scoring Holman in the 6th was the final MHS run.

In the second game, the Wildcats had Rose Hill on the ropes with a four-run 6th that put the Cats in a 5-5 tie but the hosts scored the winning run in the last of the inning. For Mulvane, Vangas led off with a base hit and Kendra Banzet walked. Holly Donaldson's single scored one. After Smith walked, Turner drilled a base hit to score one more and both Donaldson and Smith scooted home on a single to right by Holman.

The Wildcats will play a final regular season tune-up game today (May 10) when Bluestem comes to town prior to the Wichita Regional Tournament, which opens Monday, May 14. Pairings for that regional will be drawn Saturday, May 12.
