

Haven humbles Wildcats 70 - 57

The Haven basketball team moved into town on Tuesday, Dec. 21, hoping to increase their record to 4 and 2 on the season. The Wildcats, off to another basketball season, were looking for their first win of the young season.

Haven, which had already beaten the Cats in football (8-6), jumped out to an early lead and had control of the game most of the way. Senior forward Robbie Fry paced the Wildcats in scoring with 24 points. Fry hit 11 out of 20 shots from the field for 55 percent and was perfect from the charity stripe, hitting 2 for 2.

Brad Butts followed Fry in scoring with 14 points, and Dennis Moon, coming

off the bench, put in 6 points. In the rebounding department juniors Brad Butts and Perry Caldwell grabbed 23 rebounds between them.

Butts got 12 and Caldwell pulled down 11. For the game Haven hit on 43 percent of its shots as the Cats hit on 43 percent. From the free throw line the Wildcats only dunked 7 throws compared to 25 by the Haven team.

Mulvane cut their turnovers down as they committed 18 compared to Haven's 12. Senior pivotman Scott Elston was credited with 2 blocked shots and 5 rebounds. Mulvane will travel to Circle Friday night to play the Thunderbirds.
