

Mulvane Downs Rose Hill 49-22

Tuesday evening, January 4, Mulvane's Wildcats whipped Rosehill 49-22 at Rose Hill in their first basketball game of the new year.

The Wildcats started slowly, trailing 5-2, then shot into an 18-9 lead at the end of the first quarter.

The second quarter was slower than the first, with Mulvane posting a 31-11 lead at half time.

In the third quarter, Mulvane couldn't seem to get their attack, moving and the quarter ended with Mulvane leading 36-19.

In the fourth quarter, Coach Jesse Jackson substituted freely and the game ended 49-22.

The Wildcats thus far have won five games and lost none. They are averaging 60.8 points a game and have an outstanding defensive average of 38.8 points a game for the opponents.
