

Mulvane Defeats Rose Hill, 58-52

The Mulvane Wildcats racked up another basketball victory Tuesday night when they defeated Rose Hill, 58 to 52. The game, the first since the holidays, was played at Rose Hill.

Rose Hill led through most of the first half, holding a 29 to 26 lead at halftime. In the third quarter Mulvane tied the score at 30 all and then went into the lead which they held for the remainder of the game. At the end of the third period the Wildcats were ahead, 46 to 35.

Dickey of Mulvane dumped in 21 points to lead in the scoring in the game. Rapp was high man for Rose Hill with 16 points.

The Mulvane B team also won their game by beating the Rose Hill reserves, 49 to 41. High point men for Mulvane were Bachman with 14 points and Webster, who had 13. Sharp led for Rose Hill with 16 points.
