

# Wildcats Defeat Derby, 41-38.

The Mulvane high school Wildcats defeated the Derby Panthers, 41 to 38, before a packed house at the high school gym here Tuesday night. The Wildcats, after taking a lead in the first quarter and holding it throughout the contest, had to stave off a determined fourth quarter rally by Derby to win.

Mulvane jumped into a 17 to 10 first quarter lead, and at halftime, the score stood 24 to 17 for the Wildcats, as both teams scored 7 points in the second period. Mulvane scored 7 points in the third period and held Derby to 4, as they played a ball control game.

In the fourth and final period, Mulvane built up a 12 point lead, and with about a half of the period left, Derby put on a desperate rally to close the gap to two points, with less than a minute to play.

Terry Richardson led the Wildcats scoring with 13 points, followed by Dave Farber with 10. Dan Gaskin led for Derby with 14 points half of which he made in the final period.
