

Wildcats Win In Overtime

In an overtime thriller, the Mulvane high school Wildcats downed the Valley Center Hornets here last Friday night, 41 to 39. When time ran out in the final period, the score was knotted at 37 all.

In the three-minute overtime period Wildcats Moyer and Reed each scored two points from the charity line, while the Hornets were held to a single field goal, giving Mulvane their two-point margin of victory.

Moyer led the Wildcat scoring with 16 points, getting 10 of them from the free throw line, coupled with three baskets. Norden led in field goals with five, coupled with three charity tosses to give him 13 points for the night. He also led in nabbing rebounds.

In the preliminary B team game, the Mulvane reserves lost a one point thriller, 38 to 37. Mulvane was behind 33 to 20 at the end of the third period. A 17 point outburst in the final quarter brought them within one point of overhauling the Hornet reserves.

The blizzard like conditions that prevailed during the day Friday and extreme cold Friday night kept the crowd down to the smallest of the season.
