

Mulvane Wins 56-38 Game Over Clearwater

Mulvane triumphed over Clearwater 56 to 38 in a hard fought contest Friday night, January 7, to take the lead in the Sunwick League race.

Clearwater sped to an 11 to 8 lead at the end of the first quarter. The Wildcats solved the defense of the Clearwater Indians and came back to outscore them 17 to 9 and lead at half-time 25 to 20.

Mulvane held a 33 to 26 lead at the end of the third quarter and in the fourth quarter the Wildcats pulled away to win 56 to 38 for their second league triumph against no defeats.
