

Circle Upsets Wildcats, 64-58

In a hectic and slam bang finish, the Circle high school Thunderbirds handed the Mulvane Wildcats their first defeat of the season here Tuesday night by a score of 64 to 58. Circle hit on six of eight free throws in the final minute of play to seal the victory. A jam packed crowd, largest of the season, watched the hard fought game.

At halftime Mulvane held a 33 to 31 lead on the basis of a 26 foot jumper by Steve Carmichael as the buzzer sounded. At the third quarter stop Mulvane was leading, 47 to 44.

In the final period, Mulvane could hit for only 11 points, while Circle hit for 20, which enabled them to catch up and win by a six point margin. Eight of the 20 points were charity tosses.

Circle now stands 7-0 for the season, while Mulvane now has a 6 won, 1 lost record. The Wildcats played the game without the services of their leading scorer, Gordon Long, who is recovering from an ankle injury.

Jim Griggs was the leading scorer for Circle with 23 points.

For Mulvane Steve Carmichael led with 16 points, followed by Ted Richardson with 14.

In the B team preliminary, Mulvane won by a score of 51 to 45, coming from behind in the 4th period to take the contest. Alan Scott led the Mulvane scoring with 18 points, followed by Butch Woods with 10.
