Buhler played big second and third quarters into a 72-46 rout of Mulvane's Wildcats Tuesday, Jan. 12, in a Chisholm Trail League boys basketball game in Mulvane.

The loss saw the Cats' record dip to 3-4 and 1-3 in CTL play. Buhler notched its 7th consecutive victory, 4th in the league.

In two earlier games, the Buhler junior varsity whipped the Mulvane B-team, 44-23, and in a sophomore game, Derby drilled the Wildcat sophs by a 67-30 count.

The Cat sophomores quickly fell out of the contest against Derby, as the Panthers chalked up a 25-4 lead after one period. Pat McElravy led the MHS scoring with 19 points and Terry Reusser scored four.

Augusta got the Cats off on the wrong foot in January by shelling Mulvane, 55-44, Friday, Jan. 8, at Augusta. The loss snapped a modest two-game winning skein.

The MHS boys played poorly in the opening two frames, but as it turned out, that was to be their "highlight." "We played poorly in the first half and we were tied," said Mason. "I thought we'd come out and put them away in the second half but the harder we tried, the worse it got in every area of the game." It was the Orioles what put away the Cats in the final periods, out-scoring Mulvane, 16-10, in the third period and 17-12 in the last

Three players were in double figuresseniors Landes, Warren and Marcelle. Warren led the local scorers with 12 points and both Landes and Marcelle had 11-point outputs.

Warren also led the squad in rebounding with 13 caroms.

The Mulvane B-team also struggled. Augusta trimmed the Wildcat B-teamers, 54-43. Sophomore Kevin Bell scored 10 points and Robert Turner and Kevin Butler each scored seven.
