

Anthony Defeats Mulvane, 58-50

The Mulvane Wildcats dropped their second game of the season last Tuesday when they lost to the Anthony Pirates by a score of 58-50.

The Wildcats led once during the whole game, when they moved ahead of the Pirates, 10-9, with one minute remaining in the first period. Anthony then hit two quick buckets to take a 13-10 first quarter lead. The Wildcats fell behind by 11 at the end of the first half when the Pirates connected on a half court shot as the buzzer sounded.

The Wildcats trailed by as much as 14 in the third period but in the last five minutes out-scored the Pirates, 16-7, and cut their lead to 5 at the end of the third quarter. At one time during the fourth period the Wildcats trailed by only four but then had to foul to get the ball. Anthony took advantage of the free points and built their lead back up to 8, 58-50.

Dan Brauser led the Mulvane pack with 17, and Ted Hill followed with 12. Rick Farber grabbed off 14 rebounds and Jim Crawford collected 8 caroms.

After an 18-18 tie at the end of the first half, the Wildcats took a four-point third-quarter lead, 30-26. Mulvane doubled their lead in the fourth period and ended the game 8 points ahead of their opponents.

Phil Roney was the only Wildcat to reach double figures and ended the game with 16. Jeff Barton led in the rebounding department with 2 offensive and 7 defensive caroms.
