

Mulvane Defeats Andover, 68-52

TOURNEY POSTPONED

The Thursday night games at the Derby invitational basketball tournament were postponed due to the heavy snow storm. They have been scheduled for Friday evening, with the tourney finals now set for Saturday night.

The Mulvane high school Wildcats easily downed Andover, 68-52 in one of the opening games at the Derby invitational tourney Wednesday night. In the other game, Wichita Heights defeated Anthony 50 to 43.

In the semi-finals, now set for Friday night, Mulvane will play Wellington at 8 p.m. Derby will meet Wichita Heights at 9:30 p.m. The opening tilt Friday night pits Andover against Anthony at 6:30 p.m.

The Wildcats ended the first quarter of play against Andover trailing by one point, 11 to 12. However, in the second period they broke loose with a 19 point scoring burst to command a 30 to 18 lead over Andover. The Wildcats continued their pace in the final half, scoring 19 points in each of the final two periods. Larry Norden led the Mulvane scoring with 19 points. Moyer had 12 points, and McKean, Reed and Boone had 11 each.
