

Win In Overtime From Oxford, 51-48

Last Friday night was a great night for the Mulvane Wildcats. Both the A and B cage teams won victories.

The junior varsity opened the evening with an impressive 40-27 victory over the young Oxford team. And then the varsity went into overtime before beating the Oxford varsity 51-48.

Jerry Haynes opened the scoring with a tip-in and the Wildcats were not to be denied their first victory. Steve Layton hit a jump shot and a drive shot, Dale Grundeman hit a jump shot and a free throw and Phil Morgan added a follow shot to give Mulvane a 11-7 first-quarter margin.

Steve Layton and Quinn Radford each added four points in the second stanza. Two of Steve's points came on an outstanding pass from Phil Morgan. Mike Davis came off the bench to score an important field goal for the Wildcats. At half time Mulvane was ahead 22-18.

Dale Grundeman hit a field goal at the start of the second half. Free throws were added by Phil Morgan, Steve Layton, and Terry Bally. Steve Layton added a field goal. Toward the end of the third quarter, Oxford scored seven straight points to take a 31-29 lead. But Morgan and Bally each added free throws, and Terry Bally hit a field goal with three seconds left to give Mulvane a 34-33 lead.

Oxford got a quick lead in the fourth quarter. Steve Layton tied the game with a free throw and Quinn Radford hit a field goal to put the Wildcats in the lead.

Oxford came back to tie it up, but freshman Danny Brauser came off the bench to hit a field goal to give Mulvane a 39-37 lead with four minutes left in the game. Oxford took the lead with a free throw and a field goal. Danny Brauser again gave Mulvane a lead of 41-40 but Oxford came back with two points. Quinn Radford gave the lead back to Mulvane but Oxford tied the game with one minute to go.

On an outstanding pass from Danny Brauser, Quinn Radford hit a field goal to apparently give Mulvane the victory. But Oxford hit a jump shot at the buzzer to send the game into overtime.

Danny Brauser hit two clutch free throws at the start of the overtime. Brauser added a two-point shot on an outstanding pass from Quinn Radford. Radford and Brauser then each added free throws. Oxford scored three straight points but Quinn Radford stole a pass with 16 seconds left to insure the victory for Mulvane.

Danny Brauser led the "B" team victory with 18 points. Harold Calcote and Mike Flinn each added eight points.
