

Wildcats Defeat Oxford, 65-44

The Mulvane Wildcats won their third league game of the season 62-44 at Oxford Friday, January 14. The first two quarters were nip and tuck. Mulvane held a 19-14 edge at the end of the first quarter. The score at halftime was 29-26 in favor of the locals.

Oxford tied the game early in the third quarter, then fell behind 41-32 as the quarter ended.

Mulvane pulled away to win easily in the fourth quarter.
