

Planeview Downs Mulvane Quintet

Planeview's Gremlins rolled over Mulvane cagers on the Gremlins court Tuesday night 69 to 42. The Gremlins rolled up an early first half lead and let the reserves play the last half.

The Gremlins were hot during the first half having the advantage of their home court. The basketball game started slow with both teams having a time getting started. Plainview led 14 to 7, 39 to 14, and 56 to 25.

Sullivan and Gilkey poured in 12 points in the wild second period with the entire Mulvane team getting only seven.

The leading rebounder for Plainview was as usual, Bill Gilkey. He also poured in 13 points to have himself another fine night. Gilkey kept the boards clean for Plainview during most of the game and when he retired in the third quarter, Cockrum, a promising junior center took over the job.

Planeview finally got started in the final period scoring almost as many points in the last period than during the first three periods. Gayle Galvan sparked the fourth quarter rally for Mulvane, but there was never any doubt as to the outcome with most of Plainview's first and second teams sitting out the final period.
