## Rockets Manhandle MHS

It was a repeat performance but one that Mulvane High School boys basketball coach Charlie Mason would just as soon forget. The Wildcats fell behind early Tuesday night, Jan. 22, at Rose Hill and were smothered by the Rockets, 85-39, in a non-league game.

Earlier this season, Rose Hill had manhandled the Cats, 97-41.

"We wanted to control the tempo but couldn't do it," emphasized Mason, whose club remained deep in the throes of a 37-game losing streak. "We'd go down and take an ill-advised shot or turn the ball over and they'd come back and score."

Rose Hill also popped the Wildcats in a junior varsity contest to the tune of 46-42, but the Wildcat sophomores rallied in the final quarter with 19 points to mark up a 49-44 victory.

The 0-11 varsity Cats couldn't keep up after RH raced to a 20-8 advantage after one period. "The biggest factor was rebounding," said Mason. "They dominated us and controlled the boards. The referees let them physically abuse us. A lot of times we had the position but they just went over the top. They have good leapers and got the boards when they needed them."

A 18-6 edge in rebounding in the first half helped the Rockets salt the victory away early. By intermission, it was 43-14. Overall, Rose Hill racked up a 37-18 edge on the boards.

"It didn't help that we played poorly, either," added Mason. "It's the same old story. You miss five or six-footers and you're going to be in trouble. Those kinds of misses usually come back to haunt you."

MHS also missed top scorer Gary Cleverdon, who will be out two weeks with a stress fracture. Cleverdon had just appeared to catch a hot shooting streak, too.

Junior Jeff Parson was the leading scorer for Mulvane. He dumped through 12 points. Jarrod Oldridge, Danny Daniels, Steve Nelson and Andy Mackey all had four-point games.

The Cat jayvees played well, according to Coach Dale Landes, and led much of the way before RH tightened things down in the final quarter to come from behind. Top scorers for Mulvane were Judson Spicer with 12 points,
