

Mulvane Takes 3rd In Tourney

The Mulvane high school Wildcats copped third place honors in the Derby Invitational basketball tourney held last week. Mulvane downed Wichita Heights 61 to 57 in the consolation game Saturday afternoon.

In the first half, the two teams battled hard for a lead, which changed no less than eight times. The Wildcats emerged at the half-time with a 29 to 27 advantage.

Mulvane gained their victory at the free throw line, making good on 23 tosses, while Heights cashed in on only nine free throws. Deed Moyer led the Wildcat scoring with 21 points, followed by Don Reed with 17 points.

In the semi-final game Friday night, Mulvane lost to Wellington by a score of 49 to 31. The Wildcats were unable to hit the basket in the first period, and the quarter ended with Wellington leading 17 to 2. From there on Mulvane played them on even terms, and in the second period outscored Wellington, 14 to 12.

Mulvane won their opening game in the tourney last Wednesday night by downing Andover, 68 to 52. Due to the snow storm, the tourney was postponed last Thursday night, with play moved up a day.
