

Gammon, Walker Key Wildcats

A man-to-man defense which hounded Jon Martin of Andale, the leading scorer in the Chisholm Trail Conference, and a great rebounding game were the two key factors Tuesday night in Mulvane's high school basketball victory at Andale.

Coach Roger Pock's Wildcats upped their record to 3-8 overall and 2-6 in the Chisholm Trail by registering a 65-62 verdict over the Indians.

Earlier in the week, Mulvane traveled to Chaparral and the Roadrunners spanked the Wildcats, 66-47, in another league outing.

But Tuesday night was Mulvane's night to howl. The Wildcats slapped a strong man-to-man defense on Andale and pounded the Indians, 44-27, in rebounding to come from behind.

"Where we hurt them real bad is on the offensive boards," said Pock. "That's the first time we've done that all year, hit the offensive boards, I mean. Usually, we've been getting only one shot but against Andale, we got two or three."

And the offensive rebounding paid off in better shooting than normal for Pock's Wildcats. The Cats hit 24 of 46 from the field, 52.2 percent. The Indians hit only 46.4 percent, making 26 of 56.

"(Jeff) Arroyo and (Chad) Scott really did a number on this Martin," praised the Mulvane coach. "He has been averaging around 27 points a game but I put those two on him (at different times) and they held him to 19. That was another key point in the game."

Pock also had special praises for Courtney Gammon and Perry Caldwell, a pair of starters, along with Dale Walker coming off the bench. Gammon and Walker each scored 16 points and Caldwell had eight. Gammon also paced the Wildcats with 14 rebounds and Caldwell 10 as Mulvane out-rebounded Andale, 44-27. Brad Butts also had nine rebounds.

"I thought Dale Walker and Courtney Gammon found themselves again," said Pock. "Walker's been sick and his shooting has been off he couldn't hit a thing--but he found it again against Andale. I brought him off the bench because he's been a little tight. I wanted to give him a chance to relax."

Walker was a key performer in the final-quarter comeback, hitting nine points in the last period. Gammon, a 6-foot-3 junior, scored five points in the last quarter.

The B-team also hit the victory column against Andale, routing the Indians, 64-50, raising their record to 5-5.

Kevin Wyant scored 18 points and Troy Wayman pitched in with 12. The only other junior varsity player in double figures was Mark Smith and he scored 10 points.

Caldwell scored 14 points and Butts added 10 but they were the only two Mulvane players in double figures against the Roadrunners.

The B-team also lost a Chaparral. Tom Fagan scored 19 points and Smith had 10 but the B-teamers took a 63-53 drubbing.
