

Capture Trophy At Tournament

The Mulvane high school Wildcats copped the championship trophy at the Circle high invitational tourney last Saturday night by defeating Circle, 56 to 49, in the finals. In the consolation game which preceded the championship tilt, Remington edged out Pratt, 47 to 41, to take third place.

Ted Richardson led the Wildcats scoring attack in the championship game with a total of 20 points, followed closely by Steve Carmichael with 17 points. Carmichael hit a basket in the final minute of the first period to give Mulvane the lead, which they never relinquished throughout the remainder of the contest.

At halftime Mulvane held a 31 to 26 advantage, and at the third quarter mark the score stood 44 to 36 for the Wildcats.
