

Win Close Game From Peabody

In the second round of the Campus Invitational Tournament the Mulvane Wildcats met the Peabody Warriors. The Wildcats came out one point victors in a game that went down to the wire.

Peabody led by two at the end of the first period but the Wildcats led by one at the end of the second, third, and fourth.

The Wildcats' largest lead of 5 points occurred twice during the game at 34-29 and 46-41. Peabody's largest lead was 6 at 16-10 early in the second quarter.

The lead changed hands eight times during the game, six in the last half. After the Wildcats built up their 5-point lead of 46-41 the Warriors battled back to take a 47-46 lead with 2:30 remaining and then a 49-48 lead with one minute left.

The Wildcats, in a furious fuss to get the ball, fouled a Warrior with 14 seconds to play. Mulvane then called time out on the missed free throw that would have assured Peabody of at least a tie.

With 6 seconds remaining Ted Hill connected a 10-foot jumper to give Mulvane a 50-49 victory and a berth in the consolation game on Saturday.
