

Wildcats Drop 2; Andale, Augusta

The Mulvane Wildcats lost a 64-56 game last week to a tough Andale squad. Andale has been ranked among the top teams in the state and it showed it during its visit to Mulvane.

Kent Hughes led the scoring for Mulvane with 27 points. Brad Butts scored 10 points, Jeff Crawford, eight points, Robbie Fry, five points, Kent Sorensen, four points; and Ed Stunkel and Ronnie Turner each scored one point.

Stunkel did much of the backboard work with 17 rebounds. This was the second game in a row where he had 17 rebounds.

In another game last week the Wildcats fell before an always tough Augusta team 63-52.

The Wildcats could not seem

to hit their pace during the game. Robbie Fry paced the Wildcats with 15 points. Ronnie Turner had 14 points, Jeff Crawford had eight points, Brad Butts had seven points, Kent Hughes scored six points, and Mike Nichols scored two points.

Turner and Fry did an excellent job but their efforts were not enough to carry the game.

Fry had 10 rebounds to lead the Wildcats backboard game.

Mulvane is now 1-2 in league play and in fifth place in the Chisholm Trail League.
