

Boys Hit Stride At Classic, Go In Reverse At Augusta

Two one-point victories made Mulvane start thinking about becoming "Cardiac Cats" but Augusta put an end to that thinking by burying Mulvane, 56-37, in a Chisholm Trail League game Tuesday night, Jan. 27.

The two one-point verdicts were forged last week during Mulvane's drive to the consolation first place trophy in the Roadrunner Classic at Chaparral. The Wildcats got bombed by Kingman, 80-53, in Wednesday's opening round, then came back for a 60-59 triumph over Clearwater on Friday and climaxed the turn of events with a 41-40 thriller against Blackwell, Okla., to bring the consolation trophy back to Mulvane.

Mulvane coach Charlie Mason was all smiles after the harrowing back-to-back victories. "We played two pretty good ball games," Mason admitted. "Against Clearwater, we were just happy to have the last shot. It was a good team effort and everybody contributed. That last shot and rebound shot were big items but you can't overlook the contributions by (Brent) Iverson, (Darryl) Brueggeman and (Dale) Landes."

The Cats won the game on a shot at the buzzer by Greg Hamilton, who threw the ball in after a time out, circled the court and pushed a missed Cat shot back into the hoop as time ran out. The junior Landes took over the heroics the next game as his 10-foot baseline jumper with nine seconds left lifted Mulvane over Blackwell.

Actually, the Cats had to come from a nine-point deficit against the Oklahoma team in the final seven minutes of the game. "They tried to delay it for the last four and one-half minutes so we went man-to-man," said Mason. "They made some mistakes, went to the foul

line and missed and we made the most of it."

Against the Indians, Iverson scored 17 points, Landes had 14 and senior Brueggeman gunned in 10.

Two nights earlier, Iverson scored 17 against Kingman and Brueggeman added 10.

At Augusta Tuesday night, Mulvane came out like they used to think the world was flat. "We couldn't throw a pebble into the Grand Canyon," said Mason. "You look at the shot chart and it shows we shot 38 times inside the color (free throw land) and made only 10. We couldn't buy a basket and that was the story."

Hamilton proved to be the only Wildcat offense as he scored 20 points against the Orioles.

The Mulvane B-team suffered a similar fate, falling 56-39. Junior Vic Marcelle scored 10 points and Robert Turner and Joey Belden added eight each.
