

# Wildcats Lose To Valley Center, 48-45

The Valley Center Hornets gave the Mulvane Wildcats quite a sting as the Wildcats suffered their second straight league setback, 48 to 45, Friday night. Duane Langhoyer scored 25 points for Valley Center as his teammates threw a monkey wrench in the Wildcats Chislohm Trail league try. Jim Dunbar fired 17 points through, hitting six fielders and five free throws for the losing Wildcats. Peckham of Mulvane scored below his average, hitting only eleven points.

Mulvane grabbed an early lead but lost it under a barracade of Valley Center baskets. The score ending the first quarter was 18 to 12 with the Wildcats trailing. Dunbar brought the score closer in the second period of play with 10 points, while Langhoever of Valley kept his pace hitting charities. Valley led by three points at the half 33 to 30.

Coming from the half the Wildcats opened a beautiful defensive stanza holding the Hornets to only 15 points. Yet the Wildcats of Mulvane couldn't get started on offense.
