

Win Two, Lose One Game at Tourney

The Mulvane Wildcats topped the consolation bracket at the Campus Invitational which took place last weekend. The Wildcats started off on the wrong foot by dropping their first game to Peabody, 52-51, on Thursday.

Mulvane only scored one field goal in the fourth quarter and Peabody capitalized on this error by dropping in four buckets and four free throws. Jim Crawford and Dan Brauser paced the Wildcats in the game with 14 and 13 points, respectively.

Friday in the tournament Mulvane met Hillsboro for the second time this season and bombed the Trojans, 51-37. Mulvane jumped to a first quarter, 14-6, lead which was never relinquished. Ted Hill pumped in 20 points for the high flying Wildcats followed by fellow guard Dan Brauser with 11.

Bishop Carroll, who had edged by Valley Center on Friday, battled the Wildcats Saturday to determine the king of the consolation heap. The Wildcats handed the Wichita City League team their second defeat of the tourney with an impressive 61-52 victory. With the conclusion of the tournament the Wildcats' record stood at 7-5.
