Wildcats Snap **Hornet Hex**

All year long, Mulvane High School basketball coach Charlie Mason has been edgy about going to Valley Center, a place he has never came away from happy. All that changed Tuesday night, Jan. 29, as the Wildcats dealt the host Hornets a 61-55 defeat.

It was the first win for a Mason-coached Cat team in his six seasons and improved MHS's record to 11-2 and 5-0 in Chisholm Trail League play. VC fell

"Our inside people did a good job, came up with some big baskets and played the good defense," testified Mason. "And I was real proud of the way we handled their pressure late in the game. We went into our delay game for the first time this year with about three minutes left and our four guards did a good job."

Senior Lonny Travis led the Cat scorers with 20 points and Greg Quigley added 14. David Belew and Aaron Huslig also scored in double figures, Belew with 11 and Huslig with 10.

The Mulvane junior varsity remained winless as the Hornets notched a 52-43 decision. In that game, Coach Dennis Tegethoff's Cats got 13 points out of Morgan LeClair and 12 from Curtis Hicks while Andrew Swayne finished with nine.

In the sophomore contest, Mulvane's late surge fell short in a 59-56 loss. Todd Fox banged in 19 points. Jeff Williams and Bryson Butts each scored eight points.

Mason's runners continued their remarkable string of runaway victories at Goddard Friday night, Jan. 25, as they waxed the Lions, 68-43, pushing their record to 10-2 and 4-0 in the Chisholm Trail League. It also was the team's sixth victory by 20 points or more.

The game began on a solemn note with a moment of silence and a prayer for those injured in the shooting last week at Goddard Junior High and for the school's principal, James McGee, who was slain in the shooting.

The Wildcats blew the game open early with their ballhawking defense. By intermission, the Cats were up, 27-13, During the contest, senior guard David Belew had five steals and senior had four, Greg Quigley to Mulvane toward many of its 31
