

MHS Boys Can't Stop Size

Maize used a familiar inside attack coupled with a good fast break to send Mulvane reeling to its 13th straight loss this season, a 76-47 loss, Tuesday evening, Jan. 29, at Maize.

The smaller Cats couldn't stop the inside scoring once again. Junior Jeff Parson led MHS with 11 points. Jarrod Oldridge scored seven points while Toby Hoving, Judson Spicer and sophomores Chad Carpenter, J.J. Dunn and Steve Nelson each scored four.

The Mulvane jayvee, however, continued on a hot streak as the Wildcats trimmed Maize, 44-39, for their second consecutive victory. Spicer's 12 points, 11 more by Carpenter and six by Guy Alvarez paced the road victory.

Failure to shut down the pass inside cost

Mulvane a shot at breaking its losing streak Friday night, Jan. 25, at Wellington.

The host Crusaders paddled the Wildcats, 73-50, in a Chisholm Trail League game but Mulvane hung tough for most of the game to make it interesting.

"We really played pretty good," said Mason. "Our sophomore kids had fine ball games. Dunn played well on the inside and both Nelson and (Larry) Dixson performed better. The whole game swung on our inability to stop them from lobbing the pass to the big kid inside. We didn't have the size to stop him once he got it low."

Even the "veterans" for the Cats played well, although that didn't keep Mulvane from losing its 12th in a row this season.

Parson led the Cat scoring with 13 points. Senior Andy Mackey came off the bench to score eight points and both senior Hoving (six points) and junior Oldridge (seven) seemed more relaxed. Dunn also finished with eight points.

But that didn't keep Wellington from slowly pulling away in the second half. The Crusaders stretched out their lead by six in the third quarter and eight more in the last period.

It was a red letter day for the junior varsity Wildcats, scratched out their first victory of the season, a 36-30 decision.

Coach Dale Landes' club turned in one of its better efforts this year, coming from behind in the second half to hold off the Crusaders. Carpenter's 12 points paced the Wildcat jayvees. Spicer scored seven points, Dunn had five and both Dixson and Brian Heinrichs scored four points.
