

Wildcats Cinch 1st Place in League

First place in the Chisholm Trail League was cinched by the Mulvané Wildcats, Friday night, January 27, as they fought their way to a 60 - 49 victory over the Valley Center Hornets at the home court.

Mulvane has defeated Derby once, Planeview twice, Valley Center twice and Augusta once for a 6-0 league record.

In Friday night's game four of Valley Center's players fouled out, leaving but four men to play the last two minutes. Mulvane coach, Jim Parker, withdrew one of his players to even up the teams.

Valley Center was ahead at the end of the first quarter 10-8 but Mulvane managed to pull ahead by the end of the half 30-26 and at the third quarter the score was 40-39.

There were 46 fouls called, with Valley Center committing 28 of them and Mulvane 18. Valley Center attempted 33 free throws and made 23 for 70 per cent while Mulvane attempted 43 and made 30 for 70 per cent.

Jerry Webster put in 11 field goals and 9 free throws for 31 points for Mulvane and Van Tarr had 1 field goal and the season's record of 14 free throws. For the losers, Bennet and Zable had 15 and 14 points respectively.
