

# Wildcats Claw Andale, 70-64

Last Friday evening the Mulvane Wildcats managed their first Chisholm Trail league victory of the season, defeating Andale 70-64. The victory avenged an earlier defeat to the Indians. It was the Wildcats fourth victory of the season and their second in succession.

The small crowd was attributed to the cold weather and the long distance Andale had to travel.

It was the first time this season that coaches Miller and Culbertson have achieved victory for both the "A" and "B" teams. The "B" team final score was 55-38 in favor of the Wildcats. The top scorer in the first game was Deed Moyer with 20 points. He was followed by sophomore David Boone with 12.

In the main attraction, the top scorer for the Wildcats was Don Reed with 22 points. This was the season high for Don, whose previous best effort was 14 points against Derby. Ronnie Iverson and Don McKee followed Reed with 14 and 12 points respectively.

In a game which saw the Wildcats leading all the way, 11 players saw action.

The "B" game in contrast saw 19 different faces. Coach Culbertson had a slim two point margin with 3:04 remaining in the half. He then inserted the second team, who did exceptionally well as the Indians took a 2 point lead into the third quarter. The Wildcats took a commanding lead right from the start and held it the rest of the way.
