

Lose In Overtime To Goddard

The Mulvane High School Wildcats lost a 50 to 49 overtime decision at Goddard Tuesday night when Goddard scored a free throw with three seconds to go, to take a one point victory. The Wildcats had to play without the services of Steve Carmichael, one of the starting five.

The game went into overtime when Bruce Kimble hit a 20 foot jump shot with three seconds playing time left to tie the score at 47 all. In the overtime period both teams hit a field goal, and then the charity toss decided the issue.

It was at the free throw line that Goddard beat the Wildcats. Goddard made 21 of their 50 points at the charity stripe, and hit only 15 field goals in the game. Mulvane had 23 field goals and only 3 points from free throws, made from 6 attempts.

Gordon Long paced the Mulvane scoring with 14 points, followed by Bruce Kimble with 11.

The Mulvane B team won their game with the Goddard reserves, 34 to 28. Mulvane was behind through the first three quarters, but rallied strong in the final half to pull ahead in the last period and take a victory. Leading the scoring for Mulvane was Quinn Radford with 12 points.
