

Circle Defeats Mulvane Cats

TOWANDA — The Circle Thunderbirds ripped past the Mulvane Wildcats 70-42 in a game, there, Friday.

Circle capitalized on an early Mulvane frigid streak and moved out to a 14-6 first period lead. The Thunderbirds increased this margin to 26-16 at half-time.

One of Mulvane's chief problems was frigid shooting. The Wildcats hit just 18 of 57 from the field for 32 percent. Things were about as bad at the free throw line as Mulvane canned only 6 of 17 for 36 percent.

Sophomore Jerry Shoemaker, making his first varsity start of the year, led Mulvane's rebounding with eight. Troy Richardson was in second spot with seven.

Dan Carmichael, 6-5 postman,

paced Mulvane's attack with 14 tallies. He was the only Wildcat to reach double figures.
