

Plainview Overtakes Mulvane, 77-65

Plainview high school made it two wins this season over the Mulvane Wildcats Tuesday night as the Grem-lins defeated the Cats in a non-league basketball game 77 to 65. Plainview had a harder time upending the Wild-cats this time than in their first meet-ing which was played in the Grem-lin's gym last month.

Mulvane led at the end of the first period with Plainview getting off to a slow start. The Wildcats led at the end of the first period 14 to 12. Plain-view found the range in the second and wrestled the margin from the home quintet to romp to a 38 to 26 half time lead.

Plainview continued to pour on the steam in the third and fourth quarters leading 59 to 46 at the end of the third stanza. Mulvane used only six players in the entire game with three of them getting 61 of Mulvane's 64 points. Paul Armstrong and Dwayne Reusser paced the Mulvane attack with Arm-strong getting 19 points and Reusser 18.

Gilkey, the lanky Plainview center, ended up with high scoring honors for the evening with 23 points. Atkins poured in 20 points to keep right on Gilkey's tail for Plainview.
