

Wildcats Down Derby Again

For the third time this season the Mulvane high school Wildcats downed the Derby Panthers by a score of 64 to 40, in a league tussle played here Tuesday night. The Wildcats had previously beaten Derby in the opening game of the season, and again during the Christmas holidays.

The victory gave Mulvane a 12-1 record for the season, and tightened their grip on second place in the Chisholm Trail league standings. Friday night the Wildcats engage Clearwater in another home game. Clearwater is the closest challenger for the Wildcats second place spot. Augusta continues at the top of the league, and is now the only AA school in the state without a defeat.

Jerry Leatherman led the Wildcats in the game by dropping in 16 points, seven field goals and two charity tosses; Kimble had 12 points and Bowers 10. Coach Jim Parker emptied the bench as all 12 boys saw action in the tilt.

Mulvane led at all the quarter stops, holding a first period 15 to 10 advantage, and going ahead 25 to 17 at halftime. The final half the Wildcats really poured in the points, getting 16 in the third period and 21 in the final quarter.
