

Defeat Goddard Easily, 90 - 71

Last Tuesday night the Wildcats raised their season mark to 10-3 by rolling over the Goddard Lions, 90-71, in a non-league encounter held in Goddard.

The Wildcats hit 100% on the first 7 shots put up from the field and then 7 of their next 15 for an excellent 65% field goal percentage in the first quarter. The Wildcats did even better at the charity stripe. Hitting 7 out of 8 in the first period and 4 out of 4 in the second, they ended the first half hitting 92%.

The Lions, leading only once in the game, 2-0, did keep fairly close to the 'Cats. Coming from a 47-27 deficit with three minutes remaining in the half, Goddard scored 13 points to Mulvane's 6 and cut the Wildcats' lead to 13, 53-40, at the end of the first half.

The pace in the third period slowed down a bit but the Wildcats' accurate shooting stayed about the same. Mulvane hit on 9 of 16 attempts for 56%. The Lions were outscored, 19-10, in the third stanza and fell behind by 22 at the end of the period. In the final quarter the 'Cats lengthened their lead to the largest of the game, 25, with four minutes remaining. The Wildcats hit 7-14 in the final period for 50% and an overall game percentage of 54%. Mulvane hit 16 of 21 free throws in the game for an overall percentage of 76% from the line.

Dan Brauser hit 12-17 from the field, added 4 more at the charity stripe and ended the game with a total of 28 points. Ted Hill followed right behind adding 21 points to the Wildcats' 90. Jim Crawford added 6 buckets and a couple at the line for his 14 points. Max Nichols hit every one of his four attempts from the field to add 8 to the cause. Rick Farber, besides contributing 5 points, grabbed off 10 caroms and blocked 9 attempted shots.

The Wildcat J. V. squad played its first game in two weeks and defeated the Goddard Lions by 6, 53-47.

The game started out very slow with neither team scoring in the first two minutes of play. The score at the end of the first period was Mulvane, 7, Goddard, 4.

The Wildcats played a little better in the second quarter and lengthened their lead to 6 with three minutes remaining. In the next two minutes the Wildcats picked up two buckets and a free throw off an effective full court press and stretched their lead to 11, 23-12. Ronnie Pierson connected on a 15-footer, as the buzzer sounded, to give the Wildcats a 13-point halftime lead.

In the third period Goddard roared back and within the first four minutes had cut Mulvane's lead to one, 26-25. The Wildcats managed to keep barely ahead of the Lions and took a one-point edge, 32-31, into the fourth period.

The 'Cats built up their lead to 9 in the last period, 50-41, and kept it at that point for the next minute. The final score was Mulvane, 53, Goddard, 47.
