

Wildcats Win And Lose Games

Tuesday night the Mulvane high school Wildcats went to Belle Plaine where they scored a 69 to 55 victory over Belle Plaine, in a non-league basketball game. It was the second victory of the season for the Wildcats.

Mulvane grabbed an 18 to 12 first quarter lead, and were out in front 36 to 25 at the halftime break. Belle Plaine had their biggest scoring splurge in the final period, when they connected for 20 points.

McKean, the Wildcat captain, led the scoring with 18 points, and he was followed by Boone with 15, and Farber with 11.

The Wildcat B team also scored a win over the Belle Plaine reserves, by a score of 48 to 40. Mulvane led all the way in this game also.

Last Friday night Mulvane was host to the Augusta Orioles, and lost to them, 77 to 63. Augusta is now the top team in the Chisholm Trail league, as they recently beat Derby, who led the league earlier in the season.

Augusta led by five points at half time, and then widened the gap in the last half. Boone led the Mulvane scoring with 22 points, followed by Farber with 20.

The Mulvane B team also lost their game to the Augusta reserves, 67 to 62. Augusta led 51 to 37 at the end of the third quarter, with Mulvane hitting for 25 points in the final period to close the gap to a difference of five points.

Friday night the Wildcats travel to Clearwater for another league game.
