

Wildcats win 3rd game of season

The Mulvane Wildcats won their third game of the year by defeating the Chapparral Roadrunners 61 to 52. The 'Cats were paced by Robbie Fry with 21 points and Brad Butts with 17 points, with Butts also pulling down 16 rebounds. Butts picked up three fouls in the first quarter, but did not foul out. For the game Mulvane shot from the field at 38 per cent compared to Chapparral's 31 per cent. Each team received one technical foul.

Chapparral moved out quickly and held a 5 point lead at the end of the first quarter, with the score standing at 18 to 13. With 5:01 left in the second quarter, Mulvane trailed 24 to 17. The 'Cats then caught fire and led by 4 at the half 32 to 28.

In the third quarter, with 3:16 left, Mulvane led 42-33. The quarter ended with Mulvane leading 46 to 35.

Going into the fourth and final quarter, Mulvane held an 11 point lead. With 6:00 minutes left in the contest the Wildcats led by 14 points with the score 50 to 36. However, with 4:16 left, Chapparral had cut the lead to 11 points with the score at 52 to 41.
