

Wildcats Lose To Anthony, 69-65

Playing a non-league game at Anthony Tuesday night, the Mulvane high school Wildcats lost to the Pirates by a score of 69 to 65. Anthony gained its four point margin of victory at the free throw line, picking up a total of 31 points at the charity line.

The Wildcats outscored the Pirates from the field, Mulvane getting 24 field goals to 19 for Anthony, but the big difference was at the free throw line. Mulvane made good 13 free throws.

Mulvane took a 14 to 12 first quarter lead, but by halftime they trailed, 24 to 33, as Anthony hit for 21 points in the second period.

Leading the scoring drive for Mulvane was Steve Carmichael with 18 points, followed by Ted Richardson with 15.

In the preliminary contest, the Mulvane B team scored a 62 to 53 victory over the Anthony reserves. The Wildcats held a 31 to 27 half-time advantage, and they had their best scoring effort in the final period with 19 points.

Steve Roney led the Wildcat B team scoring with 25 points and Bruce Kimble followed with 19 points.
