Wildcats Mix Formula For Shooting, Winning

It's just more fun winning. Just ask Mulvane High School boys basketball coach Dale Landes. The bounce was back in his walk, the smile was back on and so were the Wildcat boys Tuesday night, Feb. 9, when Augusta was in Mulvane. The Wildcats responded with their best game of the season as they muzzled the Orioles, 70-58, in a Chisholm Trail League game.

"It was our best shooting game of the year," said Landes, whose Cats hit 57% from the field (30-51), "and one of our best efforts of the season." Earlier, the Orioles had ripped Mulvane by 15 after leading by as much as 30 points.

"Our shooting was the overall key because it just built our confidence up," added Landes. "You could see it on the defensive end. For once, our offense executed and finished the play. We made the easy buckets which hadn't been falling in previous games."

There were many heroes for Mulvane. Junior center Jason DeWald "dominated the

inside" like never before, going 7-for-7 from the field in the first half and controlling the backboards. He finished with 16 points.

Senior Brian Heinrichs had his greatest game as he had 16 points, seven rebounds, four assists, four steals and held Augusta's top player, Chris Grill, to only 11 points. And senior Brian Strack heated up in the 3rd quarter when the Orioles closed down to within three. Strack stopped the run with a couple of three-pointers and finished the game with nine points. And J.J. Dunn and reserve Chris Heersche both played excellent games. Dunn scored 13 points and Heersche had seven, five coming in the last quarter to help hold things together.

In the junior varsity and sophomore contests, Augusta buried the Cats. The Augusta jayvees pounded out an 81-54 decision and the sophs slammed Mulvane, 94-54.

Top scorers for the Mulvane jayvees were Jeff Parker with 14 points, Griff Cornejo with 10 and Dexter Carpenter with 13. Tom Nienke had six.

Mulvane's sophomores were led by James Baker's 15 points, 10 by Michael Abasolo and seven by Tim Glaser.

The intensity wasn't there Friday night, Feb. 5, when the Wildcat boys travelled to Buhler, or at least it wasn't sitting on the Mulvane side of the court. Playing poorly on the road, the Cats were pounded soundly, 87-58, by the Crusaders.
