

Cats Romp Over Clearwater

It wasn't Friday the 13th, but the Mulvane high school Wildcats racked up their 13th victory of the season here last Friday night as they downed the Clearwater Indians 55 to 36. It was a Chisholm Trail tilt, and the win kept alive the Cats hopes for a part of the league championship.

The Wildcats have two league tilts left. Friday night they go to Andale for one of them, and then they close the season at home on Friday night, Feb. 20, by entertaining the still unbeaten Augusta Orioles.
