

Rack Up Win Over Caldwell

Victory was the word again Tuesday night as the Wildcats defeated Caldwell 54-46. It was the second time this season that the Wildcats have defeated the Bluejays.

Junior sharpshooter Don Reed was high point man for the game with 23 points. This raised his season average to 9.7 points per game.

The Wildcats got off to a slow start, trailing 8-1 after 3 minutes. The quarter ended up with the Caldwell Bluejays ahead 15-10.

The second quarter saw the Wildcats come into their own. While holding Caldwell to eight points, they were scoring 14 themselves. It appeared that the Wildcats were well on their way as they took a 24-23 lead into the second half.

The second half saw the Wildcats continue on their defensive game. The half saw Mulvane scoring 30 points while holding Caldwell to 23 points.

This was the seventh victory for Coach Miller's team. It also was their fifth victory in their last six starts.

The Wildcats also won the B team game 60-51. Two juniors, making their best showing of the year, claimed the scoring honors. Jerry Jordan was high with 11 points and Roy Parker was close behind with 10 counters.
