

# Lions Sweep Boys' Season Series

Goddard made it two in a row over the Mulvane High School boys Tuesday night, Feb. 14, with a convincing 72-58 triumph on the MHS court.

The only good news for the evening was that the Cat jayvees romped by a 72-59 count and the Mulvane sophomores nipped the Lions, 47-46, in the opening game of the fray. That left the MHS junior varsity record at 3-9 and the sophomores at 4-8.

Coach Charlie Mason's Wildcat varsity dropped to 4-14 and 2-9 in the Chisholm Trail League.

Senior Larry Lambrecht popped in 27 points and Sean Gillespie had 10, the only two Cats in twin digits. Todd Hedstrom scored seven for Mulvane and Jeff Sisco, Derek Donaldson and Curtis Norden equally split 12 points.

Bill Harrington's 17 points powered the Cat jayvees along with a 19-point blast by Bruce Brashear. Scott Travis finished with 12 points for Coach Bruce Eitzen's club.

Coach Dale Landes' sophomores had two 16-point scorers, Toby Hoving and

Gary Cleverdon. Andy Mackey scored seven points and Adam Beehler had four.

Mulvane will play its final league game of the year at home against Buhler Friday night, Feb. 17.

Inconsistent play again caught up with the Wildcat boys at Wellington Friday night, Feb. 10, as the host Crusaders rallied for a 68-54 decision over Mulvane.

Mulvane built up a 14-point lead midway through the second quarter only to lose it the last moments of the second quarter and early in the third.

"We couldn't sustain anything," said Mason. "We just can't do a lot of things and were not very consistent. I think the game was lost in the second quarter when we were up by 14 and let it slip away. We were only up by two by intermission, and we were lucky to even be ahead at that time."

"We had a couple kids play a pretty good game for us but Wellington had two kids who had the games of their lives," added Mason. "We just didn't

do the job in the second half when we needed things to happen. It also didn't help to have Larry (Lambrecht) sick."
