

Two Losses For Mulvane Cats

The Mulvane High School Wildcats dropped a pair of games during the past week. Augusta wrapped up the Chisholm Trail crown by dumping the 'Cats last Friday and Campus High School thumped them, 36-42, in a non-league encounter on Tuesday.

In Tuesday's game, the 'Cats were defeated virtually before they got started. The Colts sped out to a 21-2 lead and that about wrapped up the contest. Mulvane was held scoreless for the initial four minutes of the game before Jerry Shoemaker broke the ice on a follow shot. Campus led, 24-6, at the end of the first stanza.

The Colts jumped out to a 45-20 halftime margin. Campus employed a pressing defense which kept the Wildcats at bay. The Colts had a large front line that completely dominated the backboards.

Terry Craig led Mulvane with 12 tallies. Rick Curless and Dan Birdwell had 19 points each to top Campus.

Brent Fleming has the top scoring average among players on all three Mulvane Junior High teams.

Fleming paces the 9th grade scoring with 164 points for a 16.4 average through the first 10 games of the year. Overall, the unbeaten 9th grade team has netted 462 points for a 46.2 average to 325 tallies or a 32.5 mark for opponents.
