

Wildcats Clinch League Championship

The Mulvane Wildcats clinched the Sumwick league championship last Friday night when they defeated the Clearwater Indians by a score of 66 to 47. The game was played before an overflow crowd at the local high school gym.

The Wildcats have one league game remaining, but regardless of the outcome, they are the league champions for the 1953-54 season. This is the second consecutive league title for Mulvane, as they won it for the 1952-53 season.

In the game Friday night, Mulvane took the lead in the opening period and held it throughout the contest. The Wildcats led 19 to 6 at the first quarter mark, 31 to 12 at halftime, and 44 to 27 at the end of the third period. Mulvane hit 22 out of 29 free throws for a 76 percent average, while Clearwater connected on 15 out of 25 free throws for a 60 percent average.

Jerry Webster led the Mulvane scoring with a total of 21 points. Freeman was high for Clearwater with 11 points.

On Friday night Mulvane will play Oxford in their last league game of the season.
