

Wildcats Lose To Derby, 51-41

Playing at Derby Tuesday night, the Mulvane high school Wildcats lost a 51 to 41 decision to the Derby Panthers, in a non-league game. The game was close throughout until the final quarter, when the Panthers pulled away.

At halftime Derby held a 25 to 21 advantage, and the third period was all even as both teams scored eight points. However, in the final quarter the Panthers hit for 18 points to pull away from the Wildcats, who canned 12 points in the final period.
