

Augusta Orioles Top Mulvane Wildcats

A six-minute drought in the first period provided the Augusta Orioles with the punch they needed to defeat the Wildcats, 59-45, in a "must" game last Friday on the 'Cats' home court.

But the game was decided at the charity stripe. The 'Cats hit 17 of 44 field goal attempts compared to the Orioles' 17 of 51 attempts. Augusta went to the line 14 more times than Mulvane did and hit on every one of those free trips. Thus the 14-point margin separating the two teams as the final buzzer sounded.

A similar drought occurred in the last period as the 'Cats only scored 2 points in a six-minute period. Despite these two offensively devoid periods, the 'Cats played a well-disciplined and well-fought game.

The 'Cats are now 10-6 on the year and 4-2 in league play. One league game remains as the 'Cats travel to Kingman to play the Eagles who are now leading the Chisholm Trail race with a 6-0 perfect slate. Kingman must tie for first if they lose the contest but by winning the 'Cats would wrap up a second place bid. Augusta, the other title contender, will be hoping for a 'Cat

win as they are 5-1 in league, and will benefit by a Wildcat win so they will tie Kingman for the Chisholm Trail crown.
