

Wildcats Down Rose Hill, 50-44

The Mulvane Wildcats, with the Sunwick league championship in the bag, added another win to their record in a non-league contest against Rose Hill here Tuesday night when they defeated the visitors 50 to 44. The win was by the same margin of points as the first time the two teams met this season at Rose Hill, when the score was 58 to 52.

Rose Hill led 11 to 9 at the end of the first quarter, but failed to retain that lead for long. Half time score was 24 to 18 in favor of Mulvane, third quarter score, 39 to 32, Mulvane.

High point men for the locals were Armstrong with 12 points and Webster with 13. Rapp with 11 points and Wilks with 10 paced the visitors.

The B team lost their game, 53 to 44. Although at one time the score was 41 to 42, the visitors stayed ahead on free throws. E. Carr of Rose Hill made eight free throws in the final quarter of play. The local B team won over Rose Hill when they met earlier in the season.

The final league game of the season will be Friday night when the Mulvane teams meet Oxford at Oxford.
