

Mulvane Trounces Andale, 51-24

Performing in their finest defensive game of the year, the roaring Wildcats from Mulvane high school trounced on their visiting foes, the Andale Indians to defeat them by 27 points, 51 to 24. The scoring in the game was more evenly distributed than any other up to date.

Post man, Jerry Leatherman, tallied for high point honors in the game with 11 points. The game was a fine team effort and saw nine men score in the league contest,

As far as defense was concerned, the Wildcats held the Indians to just seven field goals in the entire game. The score in the first half was rare for the visitors as only one man managed to score in the first half.

The Wildcats jumped off to an early lead 6-0 before Andale managed to score. The score at the end of the first quarter was 12 to 6.
