

Mulvane Downs Anthony, 59-49

In their last home game of the season Tuesday night, the Mulvane high school Wildcats downed the Anthony Pirates in a non-league game, 59 to 49.

Mulvane threw up a tight defense in the first half that limited Anthony to 4 points in the first quarter and five points in the second period. At halftime the Wildcats led 29 to 9. During the third period Mulvane built their lead to a 30 point bulge.

In the final quarter Anthony began to find the range of the basket, and poured in 28 points, to close the gap to 10 points in the final score. Coach Clint Hill used several combinations during the game, and every Wildcat on the bench saw action in the game. Eleven Wildcats figured in the scoring column, led by Richard Dame with 9 points, followed by Ted Richardson and Dave Farber, with 8 each.

The Wildcat B team also won their preliminary game from the Anthony reserves by a score of 67 to 59. Mulvane led, 38 to 27 at halftime.

Dallas Johns hit for 19 points to lead the Mulvane scoring, followed by Gordon Long with 13.
