

Wildcats Upset Lions

The Mulvane High School Wildcats held off a late surge to defeat the Goddard Lions 56-54 in a non-league game, here, Tuesday.

For Mulvane, the win broke a seven game losing streak and avenged an earlier loss to Goddard. Mulvane lead throughout the entire game. However, with 1:13 left, Goddard pulled within two — 51-49.
