

Mulvane Wins In Tourney Opener

In the opening round of play in the district basketball tourney being played at Caldwell, the Mulvane high school Wildcats had to go into an overtime period Tuesday night to down Caldwell 45 to 41. The game was tied at 39 all at the end of the regulation playing time.

In the overtime period the Wildcats dumped in six points while holding Caldwell to two, to take the victory.

In other round games at the tourney Belle Plaine defeated Harper 70 to 49, and Clearwater downed Goddard 46 to 42. Anthony, the other team in the tourney, drew a first round bye.

In the semi-finals to be played Thursday night Mulvane will meet Belle Plaine at 7:00, and at 8:30 o'clock Clearwater will play Anthony.

The consolation and championship games will be played Friday night, starting at 7:00 and 8:30.

The winner and runner-up at this tourney will go to the regional tourney at Haven next Thursday and Friday, March 3 and 4. The other two teams in the Haven regional will be the winner and runner-up from the Stafford district tourney.
