

Wildcats Topple Oxford, 66-54

Mulvane traveled to Oxford last Friday night to win their last league game of the season by a score of 66-54. Mulvane is undefeated in the Sunwick league for the 1952-53 basketball season.

Oxford, getting off to a fast start shot ahead of Mulvane and held a 16-10 lead at the end of the first period. Mulvane came back in the second quarter to score 20 points to Oxford's 12, ending the first half with a 30-28 lead.

The Wildcats increased their lead after intermission closing the third period 49-42 and then went on to win 66-54.
