

Wildcats Close League Play

The Mulvane Wildcats close their 1975-76 basketball season Friday night in a very important game against a tough Circle team at Circle.

The Wildcats with a league record of 2-3, are in a four-way tie for third place in the Chisholm Trail League. Circle, also with a 2-3 record, is in that four-way tie. Other teams in the tie are Goddard and Chaparral.

A win Friday night could mean a chance at the second place in the league.

On the season, the Wildcats have a 7-11 record with one previous loss to Circle by a 52-51 score. Circle has been rated as high as fifth in the state in the 3-A rankings. It had also been picked to take the Chisholm Trail League title in pre-season polls.

Mulvane is coming into the game after a 72-57 loss to Clearwater last week.

Scoring for the Mulvane-

Clearwater game was: Robbie Fry, 14 points; Kent Hughes, 14 points; Jeff Crawford, six points; Ronnie Turner, eight points; Ed Stunkel, six points; Brad Butts, four points; Mike Nichols and Brad Sorensen each scored two points; and Dan Lawless, one point.

After the game fans voted Robbie Fry as the Hustler of the Game winner.

In the "B" Team game Mulvane defeated Clearwater 63-59. The win gave the team a 7-8 record for the season.

Mulvane enters the post-season Sub State Tournament at Augusta Tuesday with an 8 p.m. game against Augusta. Augusta

has twice defeated the Wildcats this season so the game will be a tough one for the Cats.

The winner of the Sub Tournament will qualify for the Kansas 3-A Tournament at Hutchinson, Kan. This tournament will start on March 10.

If the Wildcats defeat Augusta in the sub tournament game Tuesday they will play the winner of the Goddard-Andover game at 8 p.m. on Wednesday.

If the Wildcats win Wednesday they will play at 8 p.m. on Friday. The finals for the tournament are at 8 p.m. Saturday.
